MISSIONARY OF THE WEEK - Craig and Maureen Moody, NAB Missionaries, Cameroon - For over a year now, the NAB has been praying for hostel parents for the Rain Forest International School in Yaoundé, Cameroon. The Moodys have responded to God's calling and are such a great provision: they are experienced hostel parents, having served in this capacity from 2008-2010. They are already trusted members of the NAB missionary team in Cameroon, having served a number of two-year terms. Now for the first time they are signing on as career missionaries. The Moodys will spend their first year as hostel parents in Yaoundé, Cameroon. In 2016 they will move to Bamenda to serve as the interim Field Director for Cameroon while Cal Hohn and his family return to Canada for one year of home assignment. Then in 2017 the Moodys will transition again to serve with the Life Abundant Program and take up other responsibilities which will make up their permanent roles. **Pray** for Craig and Maureen as they need to raise funds to be on the field this fall.
