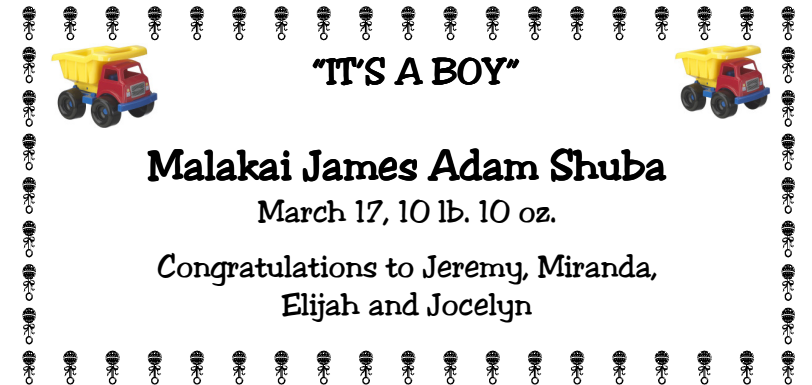


## Men's Fellowship Kick Off
