#### Luke 9

<sup>18</sup>Once when Jesus was praying in private and his disciples were with him, he asked them, "Who do the crowds say I am?" <sup>19</sup>They replied, "Some say John the Baptist; others say Elijah; and still others, that one of the prophets of long ago has come back to life." <sup>20</sup>"But what about you?" he asked. "Who do you say I am?"
